Get multiple quotes, but be wary of estimates that seem too good to be true. Reputable movers provide binding estimates based on a thorough inventory of your belongings. They should visit your home or conduct a detailed virtual survey before giving you a final price. Companies that quote over the phone without seeing your items often add surprise charges later.

Ask about their experience with moves similar to yours. Moving a studio apartment requires different skills than relocating a four-bedroom house or an entire office. Some companies specialize in specific types of moves, like piano moving or commercial relocations. Others offer comprehensive services including packing, storage, and unpacking.

Timing matters more than most people realize. The best moving companies book up quickly, especially during peak season from May through September. Start your search 4 to 8 weeks before your move date. This gives you time to compare options without settling for whoever's available at the last minute.

Insurance coverage deserves special attention. Basic coverage only pays 60 cents per pound for damaged items. That's \$60 for a 100-pound antique dresser, regardless of its actual value. Consider purchasing additional protection for valuable items. Ask about their claims process and how they handle damaged or lost belongings.
